The Club is planning to upgrade the golf courses next year and we are looking at the reconstruction of all 27 greens, practice greens and all green complexes. The plan is to close each 9-hole for a period of 6 months to facilitate the upgrading work. The entire project will take 18 months. The upgrading work will commence in the 1st Quarter of 2020, starting with Dendro, followed by Vanda and thereafter, Aranda in 2021. The projected completion is in mid-2021. Please refer to pages 8 & 9 for more information. I can understand that during this 18-month period, there will be inconveniences and limited golf slots; hence we seek members' understanding and patience during the upgrading period. But I assure you that the rewards that we reap at the end of the upgrading work will be worth the wait.



THE UPGRADING OF OUR GOLF COURSES

Built in 1993, OCC golf courses are over 25 years old, and renovated twelve years ago in 2007. Thereafter, localised improvement work on bunkers and tee boxes were carried out in subsequent years. In recent months, we have received good feedback from members and golfers about our golf courses. Despite the fact that the golf courses are in fairly good condition now, it is imperative that the Club undergoes upgrading next year.



In order to sustain the golf courses for another 11 years till the end of our land lease on 31 December 2030, it is vital for substantial upgrading work to be carried out to extend its lifespan, improve its playability, maintainability, and enhance safety of play.

After the last renovation 12 years ago, the golf course has deteriorated substantially over the years and has been facing numerous maintenance and playability issues such as:

- Poor soil profiles with high organic build-up, thereby creating sogginess, deterring water drainage and causing difficulty in sustaining healthy and playable turf and green surface. Subsoil drainage lines are also no longer efficient. As golf course playability level deteriorates over time,
- Putting surface has multiple turf contamination such as Zoysia grass, Serangoon grass and other variety of Paspalum grasses. Golfers have also commented that Greens are of
- Fairways and rough areas have multiple soggy zones which affect turf health and playability. These play areas also have high contamination of weeds thus affecting visual and consistency of play.
- Dendro bunker sand is contaminated with earth, bunker slopes have high percentage of

weeds and are losing the shape. Other feedback includes water ponding after downpour, old design, lack visual and play impact.

Irrigation system has deteriorated significantly with some parts no longer replaceable due to obsolescence of spare parts and paraphernalia. Many of the valves are also not functioning well. There are also frequent irrigation line leakages and malfunction of irrigation satellites, as well as a high number of sunken sprinkler heads and valve boxes. The irrigation system needs to be refurbished to ensure long term serviceability and minimum disruption to play.

without upgrading, OCC will not be able to maintain the golf course in acceptable play condition till 2030. With a reasonable level of golf course upgrading, OCC will then be able to stay relevant in the golf industry.





The 3 phases of golf course upgrading work is budgeted at around \$7m, which has been allocated for under Cyclical Asset Replacement Reserves.



Besides improving maintainability, systems reliability, playability and turf quality, the upgrade will incorporate new and exciting ideas into the design and contour of the greens to infuse challenging elements of play, bringing the golfing experience at OCC to the next level.



ARE YOU USING A PUTTER THAT IS RIGHT FOR YOU?


In a round of golf, putting can possibly take up between 35 – 40% of your shots. Yet the putter is, statistically, the least 'fitted' golf club in the bag (with the Driver being the most 'fitted').


Here are three quick tips to help you determine if your putter is indeed the right putter for you.

Step 1: Is your putter too short or too long?

Ideally, you would like to be using a putter built at a length where you can stand comfortably with your eyes either right on top of the ball or slightly inside of the ball.

If you hold a putter that is too long, you will be standing too far away from the ball and aiming right; and if you hold a putter that is too short, you will end up standing too close to the ball and aiming left.







Putter is too short – line of sight outside of the ball



Appropriate putter length – line of sight directly above the golf ball or slightly inside of the ball

Step 2: Does your putter sit flat on the ground?

Research has shown that the lie angle of a putter can dramatically affect the quality of roll on your putts. To put it simply, if your putter sits either too flat or too upright on the ground, the ball could easily wander off line, even if you have aimed straight.







Step 3: Are you using a putter of the right shape?

Each of us perceives objects differently, which is why the shape of the putter could either help or confuse you. If you have a left aim tendency, your putter could have too many squarish shapes or lines. If you have a right aim tendency, you could be using a putter that does not have sufficient aiming aids or is too round for your liking.



Hopefully the three tips above will help you make a better decision when it comes to choosing the right putter to hole more putts!
