The year 2018 started off on a delightful note with many members taking part in the Gold Medal event and the Hong Bao Golf Special to celebrate the Lunar New Year. To make the festive season more joyous, precedence was set to invite Winners of the Men's Club Championship, Ladies' Club Championship, Club Matchplay Championship and Gold Medal Event to the Dinner & Prize Presentation Ceremony during the Hong Bao Golf Special to honour their championship titles in due recognition. Looking at the good participation rate, I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for your stoic support. The team at OCC will continue to organise various golf events and programmes to forge stronger bonding and camaraderie among members, and we look forward to your continued support. Golf Course and Facility Enhancement Works

On 30 January 2018 (Tuesday) evening, our golf courses were hit by torrential rain and strong winds, which left a large number of trees uprooted and affecting the playability of the golf courses. Our Golf and Property & Maintenance Teams, together with the Team from our course maintenance partner, TEHC International Pte Ltd, took prompt and swift actions, working till late into the night to attend to repair works and also to conduct safety inspections. With the prompt restoration of the course condition, play resumed the next day and there was minimal disruption to members' golfing slots. I am proud to share that this swift restoration of the impacted areas at the courses would not be possible without great team efforts and commitment by the entire maintenance team to ensure the playability of the courses for members. Good Job!

As we take pride in being a premier Golf Club, the Club continues to invest in regular course maintenance works with great emphasis on intensive cultural practices such as intensive weeds control, hollow tinning, top dressing of the greens and verti-cutting of the fairways and roughs, which have been planned for the year to further improve the condition of the courses. As we witness the healthy root length on the greens, we will try to gradually increase the green speed by a notch to 9 feet during weekends and public holidays for your enjoyment. Golfers thus can look forward to a challenging and yet true green putting experience. In addition, you will be pleased to know that the bunkers upgrading work at Aranda is now 100% completed. Since 5 February 2018, the upgrading and repair works has also commenced on the remaining 24 bunkers at Vanda course and soon members will have an improved bunker playing experience at Vanda.

For the Driving Range, I am pleased to share that on 15 January 2018, a total of 100,000 Range balls were replaced with new ones to enhance your practice experience and we have since received positive comments from members and guests.

Major Projects in the Pipeline

As we constantly strive to deliver our best to serve you better, I am also excited to fill you in with news of two major projects that the Club will be rolling out in 2018. The Club will be introducing an online advance golf booking platform of tee times for social games via an interactive website at your convenience. In-person bookings on Fridays for play on the following weekends will continue to be available to members before slots are opened up for Online booking. Members can look forward to a whole new service experience and ambience as the premises will be converted into an air-conditioned environment with cosy waiting areas and refurbished furniture to welcome you and your guests. New MHA Rulings for Jackpot Room with effect from 1 May 2018 (Tue)

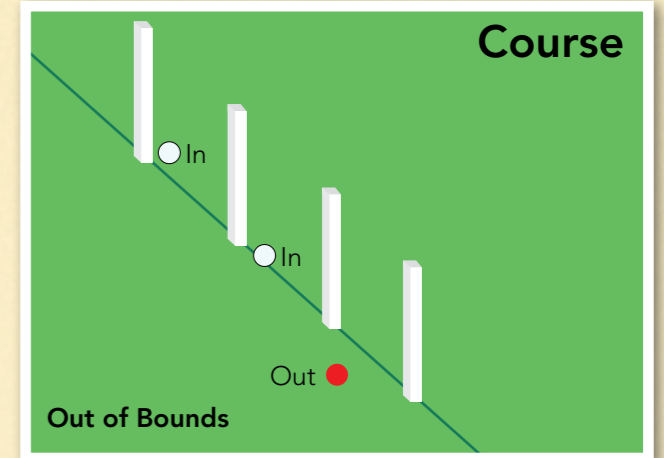

When is a Ball Out of Bounds (OB)?

Out of Bounds (OB) refers to a scenario whereby a golf ball goes beyond the boundaries of the golf courses or any part of the courses, as marked by the Committee using white stakes and/or lines. White stakes serve to indicate OB and the lines define OB.

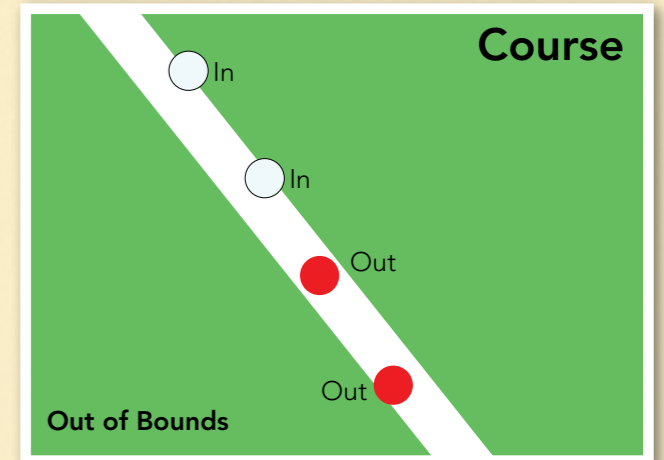
In OCC golf courses, OB is indicated by white stakes:

- The imaginary OB line is determined by the nearest inside points of the white stakes at ground level (excluding angled supports).
- If your ball touches an OB white stake but part of it is still on the course, the ball is considered in-bounds. However, if the entire ball lands outside the imaginary line, the ball is considered out of bounds.
- OB white stakes are fixed and not classed as an obstruction. Hence, there will be no free relief if they impede your movement, and they may not be removed in accordance with USGA Rule.



At major competitions, OB is defined by white lines on the ground:

- The line itself indicates out of bounds.
- A ball is out of bounds when all of it lands on or beyond the line. If any part of the ball still touches the course, the ball is considered in-bounds.
- The OB line extends vertically upwards, so if your ball is lodged in a tree on the boundary, judgement will be made on that basis.

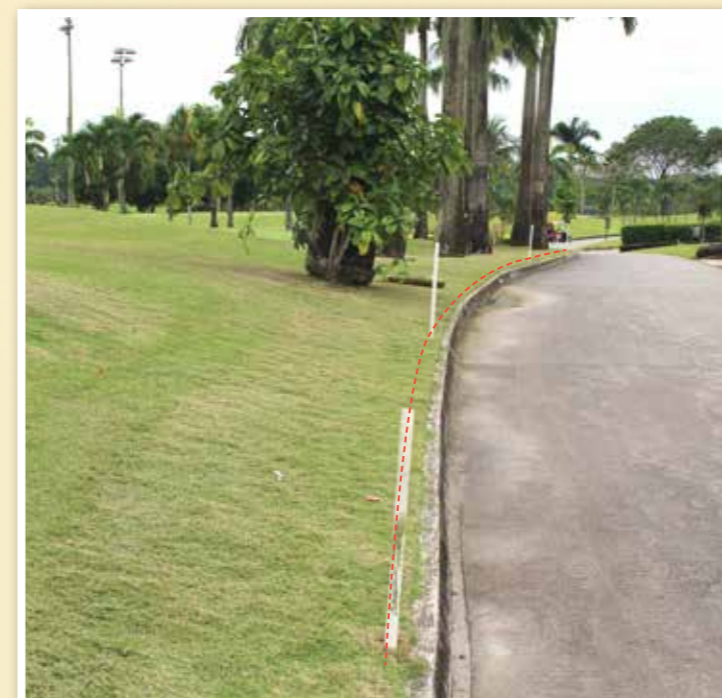


Legend:

Important Points to Note:

1. If your ball is considered in-bounds, you may stand in the out of bounds area to play the ball lying within bounds.
2. If your ball is out of bounds, the game will still continue and you may play another ball from where you last played the shot, adding one stroke penalty to the score.

CRUNCH TIME – THE MENTAL APPROACH TO CHIPPING

Decisions are constantly made in golf and with experience, we make better decisions. Keeping a lookout for the critical factors makes a big difference too. Every shot we play around the green requires some degree of thought and planning. The better we become at making these decisions, the more committed we will be in our shot executions, and this will reflect in our performances.

Critical Factors (Decisions & Preparations)

1. Different Lies – Big Determining Factor

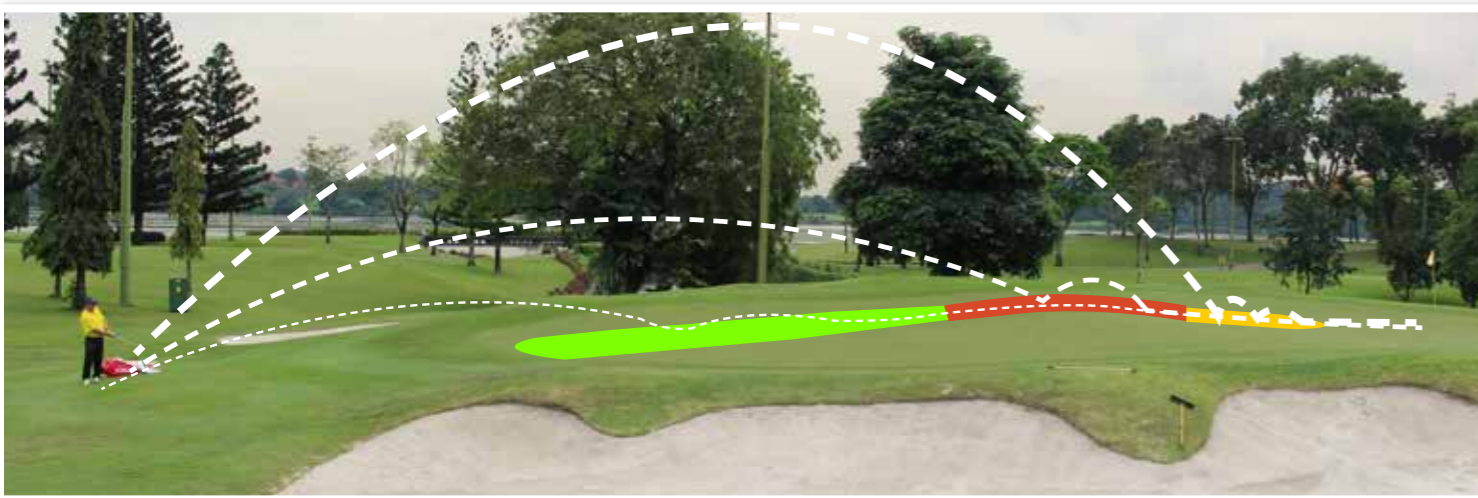


This is a floater, where the ball rests high up on well-cushioned grass. It's easy to hit high shots but be careful not to swing too deep, otherwise the contact will be high up on the clubface.

This ball is sitting down in well-cushioned grass and not easy to get under the ball. Either hit down more and a lower shot will result or play it like a bunker shot and purposely chunk it.







This is a tight lie, either fairway or fringe. You should brush the grass with a descending blow, which will create a lower flight. It is tough to hit high shots off this lie.

2. Landing Areas – Shot & Club Selection

For most of our full shots, the ball would ideally be spent flying. However, for short shots, the ball is spent largely bouncing and rolling. That is why we must consider the landing area in which the ball will be bouncing and rolling on, and the first bounce is the most important. Before deciding on your shots, it is good to walk up and survey the landing areas first, as it helps you to feel the distance to the landing area. On top of that, selecting the right type of shot to play and club to use, based on the landing areas, is an important decisive factor too. The following are examples of some landing areas at the 7th Hole Dendro at OCC (Consistent Upslope, Crest of Hill or Consistent Downslope).

Consistent Upslope

Type of shot: Low shot
 Club to use: 7 or 8 Iron

This is the best choice as it gives you the biggest area to shoot for. Considering the tight lie, a shot with the ball low and running is preferable. The shot needs to be judged well as the ball could be hit over the back of the green if you are not careful.

Crest Of Hill

Type of shot: Low shot (SW) or Normal shot (PW)
 Club to use: SW or PW

This is the least preferred option to take as it requires you to land the ball on the crest of a hill. Any misjudgement made with your landing spot would magnify your mistake.

Consistent Downslope

Type of shot: Lofted shot
 Club to use: LW

Landing the ball over the hill would require a very lofted shot. Lofted shots require bigger swings. However, it is not easy to get under the ball as the ball is sitting on a tight fairway lie, and there is danger over the back of the green. You would be taking on unnecessary risk with this option.

3. Pre-Shot Routine



Once the shot and club are selected, get engaged through visualisation.

Feel the shot through practice swings beside the ball in a similar lie.

Execute the shot once your feel matches the preview swing in your mind.

Much of your short game success is going to be up to your imagination, how clearly you see the shot that you believe will get you the result you want. Like putting, it is one of the few areas of the game where feel, intuition and our visual senses are best used to judge the shot. It is encouraged to spend some time to visualise perfect shots in your mind before you hit the ball. **Do not be afraid to dream big, hole it!** If you only visualise what could go wrong, you may find that things will generally go wrong. It may not unfold exactly how you see it, but having positive and clear thoughts, visualising and feeling prior to your execution will result in lower scores.

TIPS

- Keep a very light grip pressure on your golf club and you will have a better touch as you hold it. As your confidence grows, you will have more faith in a lighter grip pressure too.
- Keep your mind focused on what you want the ball to do and the feeling you believe you need, to see the ideal shot come to fruition.

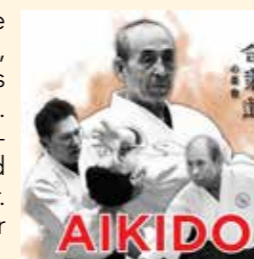

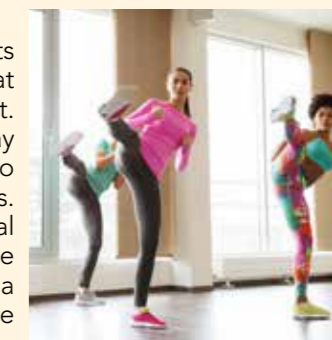

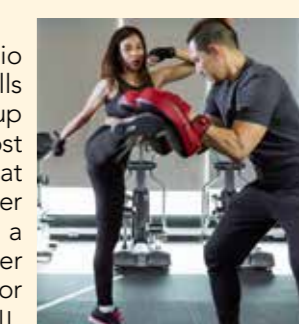

BURN YOUR BODY FAT & KCALS!

Keep your eyes on the timer. Complete 1 Burpee Pull-up for the first 30 seconds. Then add an extra rep every 30 seconds subsequently. When you cannot fit all your reps into 30 seconds, just perform Burpees. When your Burpees no longer fit into 30 seconds, your set is over!



02 FAST TRANSITIONS

Burpee Pull-ups are easier than straight ones as you will be using momentum from the jump to pull yourself up the bar. From the straight-arm plank position, jump up with both knees close to your chest, sit back into a squat and jump quickly upwards to grab the bar.



03 HOLD FOR A SECOND

Grab the bar with a wider than shoulder-width overhand grip and pull your chest as close to it as possible. Hold for 1 second before lowering down with control. Drop back down and stand tall. You've completed 1 rep.



01 HIT THE FLOOR

Drop from a standing position to plant your hands on the floor, while kicking your feet out into a straight-arm plank position. Do a push-up, touching the floor with your chest, before launching back up to full extension.

Perfect your pulling technique with this dynamic movement!

Trainer Tip:

For a start, instead of getting up and down as quickly as possible, break the movements down. Take it as a three-move giant set.

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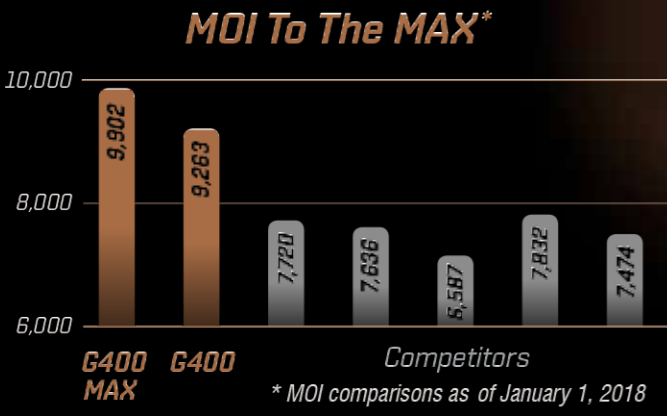

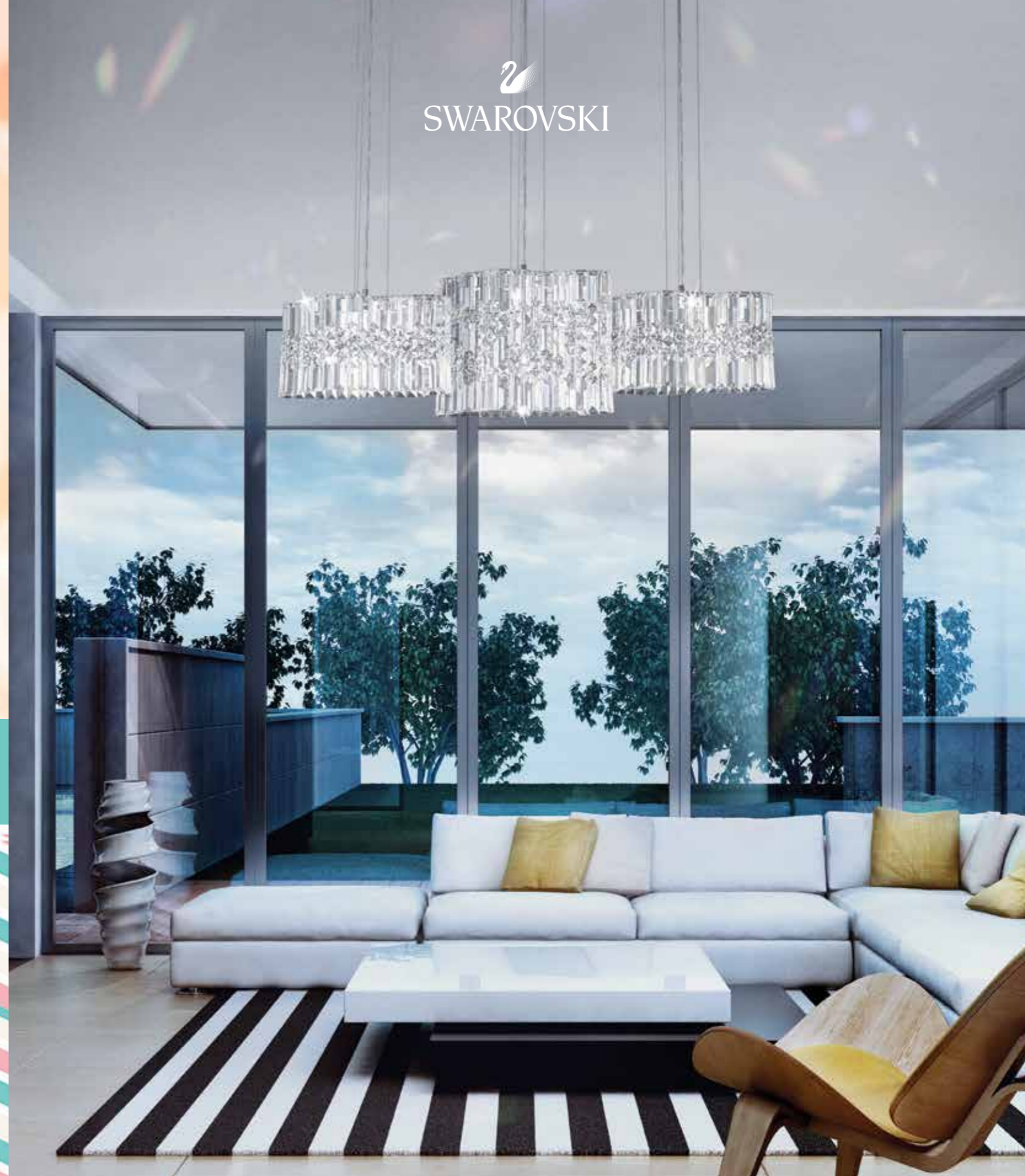
