

INCLEMENT WEATHER MANAGEMENT

- 1. Golfers in the morning timesheet must complete the first 9-hole and tee off on the first tee on the next 9-hole by 11:45am. Failing which, golfers must cease play after 9-hole.
- 2. If inclement weather continues into the afternoon session, all players from the morning timesheet must complete their game by 2pm, failing which, they shall cease play and make way for the afternoon timesheet golfers.
- 3. On days where the course is opened for Night Golf, golfers playing in the afternoon timesheet must complete the first 9-hole and tee off on the first tee on the next 9-hole by 4:15pm.
- 4. Golfers who fail to cross over by the above stipulated time as a result of slow play or inclement weather will not be permitted to cross over.
- 5. Golfers must not skip holes in order to cross over in time.
- 6. For evening 9-hole, play may commence only after the last afternoon timesheet golfers have crossed over and are at least one hole clear.
- 7. Golfers who have played less than 3 holes when inclement weather affects play, and cannot resume play due to prolong suspension and / or voluntarily give up the game, will be charged 9hole rates.
- 8. Golfers whose tee time is affected by the suspension of play, and who have not teed off, can get a full refund.
- 9. The Club may, in its absolute discretion and without prior notice or assigning any reasons, suspend or modify the control of play for the purpose of meeting special contingencies.
- 10. During inclement weather when play is suspended, flights that are already on the golf course must proceed to the following areas to seek shelter:
 - a. Nearest rain shelter
 - b. Buggy area
 - c. Octagon
 - d. Vanda Terrace
