Terms of Competition

1. The OCC Club Championship is open to all male (HI 11.4 & below) and female (HI 18.4 & below) amateur golfers from the following membership categories:
 - OCC Golfing Gold
 - OCC Golfing Silver
 - OCC Weekday Term Golfing
2. Handicap Index containing Excessive Penalty Scores will not be accepted.
3. Players may not take a voluntary cut in their Handicap Index.
4. If a player has his/her Handicap Index maintained at more than one Club, he/she shall play off the lower/lowest Handicap Index.
5. All entries will be subject to the Organizing Committee's approval (OC), which reserves the right to accept or refuse or, having accepted, subsequently reject any entry without giving a reason for its decision.
6. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by R&A Rules Limited.
7. The Championship shall consist of 54 holes Stroke Play in three rounds of 18 holes each.
8. A minimum of 8 eligible players per division must register for the Championship to proceed.
9. There shall be no cut offs for the Championships.
10. Pairings for Round 1 and Round 2 shall be determined by the Tournament Director.



11. The draw for the final round will be based on the cumulative gross scores of the preceding round/s.
12. Players shall start at the time and in the order indicated in the draw. No substitution of players and changes in starting times shall be permitted after the draw has been made.
13. The OC reserves the right to fix and/or alter the starting times.
14. In the event if any round cannot be completed, the round shall be abandoned. The result of the tournament will then be based on the completed round/s.
15. For the nett prizes, the Handicap Index to be used for every round shall be the current handicap at the beginning of the competition.
16. In the event of a tie for the Championship, the winner shall be decided by a sudden-death paly-off. In the event of a tie for other positions, the OCC countback system shall apply.
17. Prizes will be awarded in the following order:-
 - i. Champion
 - ii. Runner-Up
 - iii. Overall Best Nett
 - iv. Daily Best Gross
 - v. Daily Best Nett
18. The Champion and the Runner-Up are not eligible for the Overall Best Nett Prize while the Daily Best Gross Winner shall not win the Daily Best Nett Prize.
19. Late cancellation fees are only applicable for the first round of the competition.
20. The Tournament Director reserves the right to amend these Terms of Competition at any time. All decisions made by the Tournament Director are final.
21. Once officially posted, all decisions are final and binding on all participants.
