



Updates on Golf Matters in view of Vanda Course Upgrading

With the ongoing upgrading works at Vanda Course, please take note of the following when golfing at OCC.

1. Internal Out of Bounds (OB) on Dendro

Construction for Vanda Hole 7 is underway; to ensure golfers safety when playing on Dendro Hole 7, we have erected construction netting along the fairway between Dendro 7 and Vanda 7. This is to prevent golfers from entering the construction site and risk getting injured.

Internal Out of Bounds

During play on Dendro Hole 7, the area beyond the white stakes on the left of the fairway is defined as out of bounds. These stakes are treated as boundary objects during play on Dendro Hole 7. For all the other holes, they are immovable obstructions.

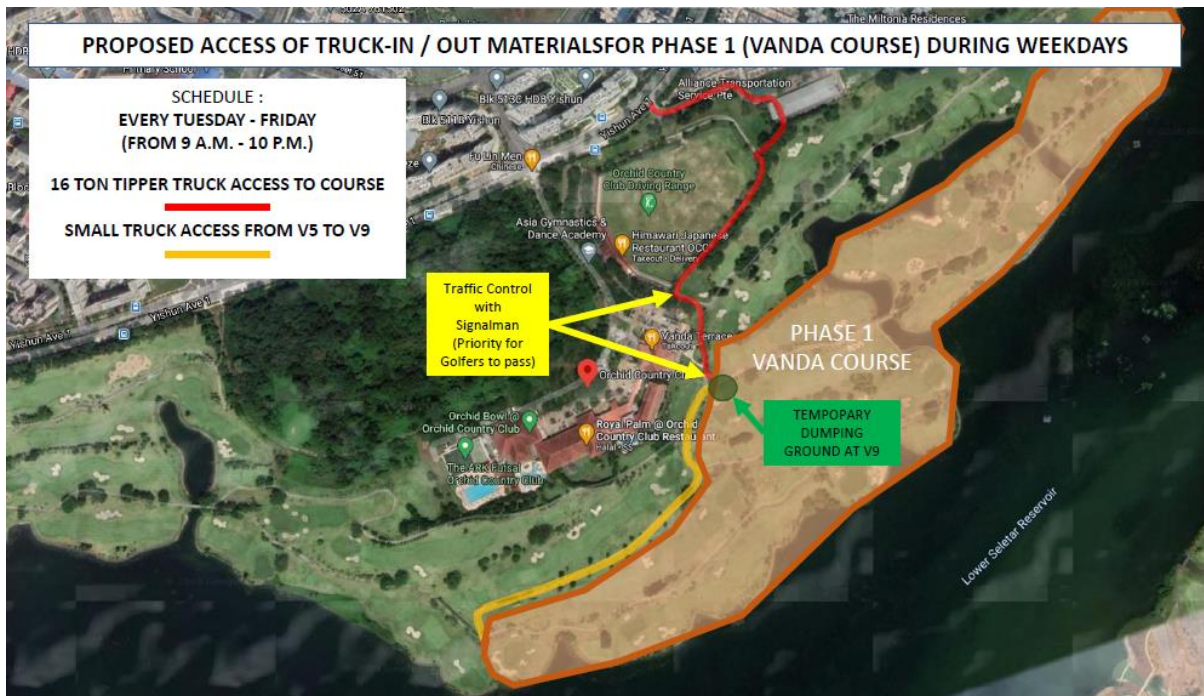


2. Removal of Soil from Vanda Course

As the contractor unearths more of the greens on Vanda course, they will need to transport the dirt to the dumping ground more frequently.

We seek members' understanding that tipper trucks have to be used to efficiently transport the dirt to the dumping ground. The contractor will be deploying traffic controllers at strategic areas to help direct buggy and truck traffic. The route which the trucks will be using starts from Vanda 9 green (in front of VT), goes past the putting and chipping greens, and heads towards the Driving Range.

The Management will work closely with the contractor to ensure that there will be minimal inconveniences for our members.
