FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

Dear Members and Friends,

It is my pleasure and privilege to join the Orchid Family on 1 February 2020 and to pen my first message as the General Manager of Orchid Country Club (OCC). I am not new to OCC. I have been an active member since 2013 and last served as the Chairman of Handicap Committee and member of the Greens Committee from 2017 to 2019. It is no coincidence that many familiar faces have come up to me to give their valuable feedback and suggestions. I am excited and immensely grateful for this opportunity to further contribute and work alongside a committed team to serve all of you, members of OCC and the Labour Movement family!

Starting off a new phase of our OCC journey was the annual Lion Dance performance, Hong Bao Golf Special, Bowl and Dinner on 2 February 2020 (Sunday) to usher in good health and prosperity for the year of the Rat. It was indeed heart-warming to see close to 200 golfers, 50 bowlers and over 400 diners from OCC, Aranda Country Club, *my golf kaki* and friends enjoying themselves, with so many happy faces and lucky draw winners. A big thank you to all OCC members and guests. Without your overwhelming support and participation, this annual festive celebration would not have been possible. Let us continue to work together to **raise the overall vibrancy, patronage and utilisation of the Club facilities and services**.

As part of the Club's upgrading and enhancement of facilities, I am delighted to share with you that we had finally completed the refurbishment of all OCC restrooms, as well as the Olympic and Fun pool changing rooms. Our car park, common corridor and walkway street lightings had also been replaced with LED lights for energy efficiency, improved safety, and a brighter and more secure environment. We have also changed all the carpets and bed mattresses in the hotel rooms, to provide a more conducive, comfortable stay for our members and hotel quests. Re-painting of the Club's main building facade, interior furnishing and other improvement works are also in progress. We had earlier shared with you on our golf course upgrading work and schedule in previous issues of Orchid Ripples. Besides improving irrigation system reliability, course maintainability and turf quality, the golf course upgrading will incorporate new design and contour of the greens to infuse challenges and bring the golfing experience at OCC to the next level. We are certainly looking forward to see a revamped OCC hardware.

Beyond the hardware, we are also rejuvenating our 'heartware'. Since coming under the ownership of NTUC Club, we now have access to an extensive pool of resources and network with greater synergies. We have been working closely with NTUC Club to develop new initiatives and

better privileges for you. For a start, this includes a one-time complimentary nEbO membership, 'U Run Get Fit Pass' that is offered to members at an exclusive price, and complimentary use of practice green, putting course and range system at MBGC for our golfing members. You can refer to our brandnew section called, 'Our Family', on pages 4 to 7 for more details of these privileges. Moving forward, we are excited to be presenting to you more benefits and better access to NTUC Club-wide facilities, social and recreational activities such as Wild Wild Wet, eXplorekid, Scarlet City and many more.

With the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak, I would also like to keep you updated on the current situation at OCC. We are adhering to the advisories issued by the Ministry of Health. Mandatory temperature taking and health/travel declarations have been implemented, along with various precautionary measures such as intensified cleaning and disinfecting high-traffic areas among other protocols to ensure the safety of our members, guests and staff during this period. Please be reminded to stay at home if you are unwell with fever or respiratory symptoms such as cough or shortness of breath, had recent travel history to mainland China, South Korea, Iran or northern Italy, or have been placed on Stay-Home Notice (SHN) for the full 14 days. Should you feel unwell while at OCC, please approach our staff immediately for assistance. We are constantly monitoring the situation and at the time of writing, the annual OCC Captain & Lady Captain's Cup is still happening on 29 March 2020.

I would like to seek members' kind understanding, patience and cooperation as we execute these measures. On our part, we have also implemented quicker and more efficient method such as QR-code/ online health declaration to streamline the process for faster registration. We are all in it together as viruses know no borders, boundaries nor nationalities and these measures will only be effective if everyone plays his/her part, and exercises social responsibility.

With the recent spate of dangerous play incidents on the golf course, I would like to urge golfers to exercise more patience towards fellow golfers. Patience is the key to playing great golf. Let's start with M.S.A tips (page 20) on the golf course and once you learn to become more patient, then you will not only start to see better scores but also find more enjoyment in your game. Some guick tips on speeding up play have also been included on page 20. I would also like to take this opportunity to remind golfers of the Handicap Index (HI) restrictions on weekends and public holidays. Only male golfers with a HI of 18.0 and below are allowed to tee off from the blue tee while ladies with a HI of 12.0 and below are allowed to play off from the white tee. In the event that anyone in a flight with all male golfers has a HI above 18.0, the whole flight must tee off from the white tee; if anyone in a flight with all female golfers has a HI above 12.0, the whole flight must tee off from the red tee.

In closing, I would like to extend my sincere appreciation to all of you for the support you have given us over these years. My job as the GM is to bring OCC to greater heights. I will work hard with my team to constantly improve our services and quality standards to provide the best experience for all members of OCC and the Labour Movement family.

Here's wishing you a Happy Easter filled with love and happiness. Stay vigilant, active and healthy, and see you at the Club soon!




New STAFF LOUNGE & CAFETERIA



LET'S PRACTISE GOOD GOLF ETIQUETTE!

With the recent spate of dangerous play incidents on the golf courses, we would like to highlight to all golfers two noteworthy cases that were brought up to the Disciplinary Committee (DC) involving OCC and MGK members and their guests.

Case 1

Three OCC members and their guest teed off in spite of the flight in front of them still being clearly within range and sight. Their balls landed dangerously close to the golfers before them, with one ball hitting a buggy. The DC had decided that the entire flight had committed dangerous play, and as a result, their memberships were suspended for 3 months and their guest declared *persona non grata* for 6 months.

Case 2

A flight of 3 balls consisting of two MGK members and an OCC member was on Dendro 9 fairway when one of the MGK members decided to play his second shot from under a tree using a pitching wedge, hoping to hit only 90 to 100 metres forward, when the group in front was some 40 to 50 metres to the green. The ball landed just behind a golfer in front of them. The MGK member did not shout "fore" nor did he approach the group in front to apologise; instead, he claimed that it was a thin shot that flew further than expected. The DC had decided that the MGK member's action had posed a danger to fellow golfers. The penalty has not been finalised yet at the time of publication.

The Club views dangerous play on the golf course very seriously. Golfers who have committed dangerous play will be taken to task and penalties meted out by the DC. Many past disciplinary actions taken against OCC members saw their memberships suspended up to 12 months. Non-members will be declared persona non grata. His penalty is twice the period of the OCC member's and he will be prohibited to golf and use any of the Club facilities during this period.

Safety is of paramount importance when golfing. Here are the M.S.A tips:

- Maintain a good distance from the flight in front of you.
 If you are unsure whether it is safe to take your shot, make
 the extra effort to go forward to check on the golfers in front.
 Ensure the golfers in front are out of range before you play
 your shots.
- **Shout 'fore'** immediately if you or your flight mate(s) hit a bad shot in the direction of another flight.
- Apologise. Saying 'sorry' may be the best way to express your regret that you have made a bad shot. A simple apology does go a long way.

Let's all play our part in practising good golf etiquette! A safe environment definitely makes a happier golfing experience!

HI Restrictions

Please be reminded that Handicap Index (HI) restrictions apply to all golfers on weekends and public holidays.

- Only male golfers with HI of 18.0 and below are allowed to tee off from the blue tee while ladies with HI of 12.0 and below are allowed to play off from the white tee.
- In the event that anyone in a flight with all male golfers has a HI above 18.0, the whole flight must tee off from the white tee; if anyone in a flight with all female golfers has a HI above 12.0, the whole flight must tee off from the red tee.

Quick Tips to Speed Up Play

- **Plan your shot** while walking to your ball or while others are playing.
- **Line up your putt** when others are putting.
- **Be ready** to play when it is your turn.
- Walk briskly between shots.
- Walk directly to your golf ball; don't follow others unless assisting in a search.
- If driving/riding a buggy, take several clubs with you to your ball so you do not have to walk back to the buggy.
- **Do not step off yardage** for every single golf shot.
- Develop an eye for distance.
- Be efficient with **pre-shot routine**.
- **Minimise** the number of practice swings.
- Play a provisional ball if you think the original might be lost outside a water hazard or go out of bounds.
- Leave your clubs on the side of the putting green towards the next tee.
- Exit putting green promptly after holing out.




