We will be implementing more benefits to the card, so keep your eyes peeled for new updates in the Orchid Ripples.

The Club has been closely monitoring the condition of the golf courses to ensure that they are kept at the best condition for members' enjoyment. Improvements were made in most areas of play particularly on the greens. The greens turf has become more resilient with higher tolerance to foot traffic and change in weather pattern, and turf growth is more sustainable with higher turf density. Various cultural practices are also carried out on the greens resulting in smoother putting surface, truer line of putt and faster greens with improved consistency throughout the 27 greens.

I am happy to announce that with the completion of the restroom upgrading at the Level 2 Conference Room at the Golf Clubhouse in end 2018, we have concluded our Club-wide restroom upgrading project. While it was inconvenient during the renovation stage, the luxury and comfort that the new restrooms provide made the wait worthwhile. I would like to thank our members for their patience during the upgrading phase.

Looking ahead, I would like to share that the Club is looking at large-scale upgrading work on the important play areas in all 27 holes of the golf course, in which works would begin in early 2020. The upgrading work is necessary to extend the lifespan of the golf course, further improve the playability and enhance its character. The upgrade will incorporate new and exciting ideas on the design and contours of the greens and create one signature hole for each course to enhance the memorability and challenging

element of play. Other upgrading work will also include safety enhancement, better quality of turf on fairways and immediate rough, bunker improvement, etc.

We will also be upgrading the Male and Female changing rooms, from 20 February to 20 March 2019 and 24 March to 30 April 2019 respectively. Members will also have another option for booking of golf games as the online golf booking platform will be going live in September/ October 2019. More details will be made known to you in due time via our Club announcements.

IMPROVING IMPACT

One of the prerequisites for good ball striking is ball-first contact, i.e. striking the ball before the ground.




Improper post-impact position that results from striking the ground first

Often, a golfer would have struck the ground first if he/ she has a post-impact position that looks like the one above.



Striking the towel before the golf ball

If you swing the golf club and find that your club strikes the towel first before you hit the golf ball, you are positioning yourself in a wrong way.



A good way to encourage ball-first contact is to improve the club and ground contact location. To practise this, place a towel 3/4 foot length behind your golf ball.



Better balance with pressure being put on the front leg

Therefore, the intent is to practise hitting the golf ball without coming into contact with the towel. This will often result in a better post-impact position like the one above, where you will have better balance with pressure being fully put on the front leg.

Follow the tips above to improve your ball impact position and you will become a better ball striker in no time!


TIGHT AND STIFF SHOULDERS? TRY OUT THESE 6 MOBILITY STRETCHES!

1. HEEL SIT CAT/COW



- Set up on hands & knees
- Sit hips back toward heels
- Push into floor & round upper back (cat)
- Then look up toward ceiling & arch back (cow)
- Go back & forth through full range of motion
- 8 reps

3. CHILD'S POSE LATS STRETCH



- Set up on hands & knees
- Sit hips back toward heels & reach arms overhead
- Walk hands over to 1 side until you feel a stretch in your lats
- Hold 60 secs per side

5. HEEL SIT SINGLE ARM LIFT-OFFS



- Sit back toward heels with arms overhead & wrists on foam roller
- Thumbs pointed up toward ceiling
- Without lifting hips off heels, lift 1 hand off roller, keeping elbows straight
- Hold for 3 seconds, then switch sides
- 8 reps per side



- Set up on hands & knees
- Sink chest down toward floor & retract shoulder
- Create big circles with your shoulder blades by pushing back into floor & then sinking back down in a forward circular motion
- Repeat in a backward circular motion
- 8 reps each direction

4. HAND BEHIND BACK T-SPINE ROTATIONS



- Set up on knees & elbows
- Place right hand behind back, palm up toward ceiling
- Lower left shoulder toward floor, then rotate toward
- Try to increase range of motion each rep

6. FOAM ROLLER PEC STRETCH



- Lie down with roller along spine & head supported


