Announcement Individual Membership Transfer Fee Reduction

This year marks the 25th Silver Jubilee Celebration of OCC; a milestone that cannot be accomplished without your stoic support, loyalty and active participation and patronage of the Club's facilities, events and activities.

The Club and its Proprietor have reviewed the transfer fee structure of all Individual membership categories, and are pleased to announce with immediate effect from **2 July 2018 (Monday)** that the transfer fee for the various Individual membership categories shall be reduced as follows:-

Please note that the membership transfer fee reduction does not apply to Corporate, Union Corporate and Term Memberships.

All Individual membership transfers shall be suspended for a period of two (2) weeks from 2 July 2018 (Monday) to 16 July 2018 (Monday) so as to allow sufficient time for potential transferors and transferees to adjust to the new market pricing dynamics and take the reduced transfer fee (where applicable) into consideration.

As a gesture of goodwill, for all Individual memberships' transfer applications received in June 2018, the transferor shall be allowed to "withdraw" his/her transfer application by completing and submitting the "Withdrawal of Transfer" application form to the Membership Department **on or before 16 July 2018** (Monday), provided that the application form is duly acknowledged and signed by the transferor and transferee; and subject to the approval of the General Committee whose decision shall be final and binding.

Any subsequent transfer shall be carried out with the submission of a fresh application for the transfer of membership to the Membership Department for processing and subject to the approval of the General Committee whose decision shall be final and binding.

We are pleased to announce that the Club and its Proprietor have reviewed the transfer fee structure of all Individual membership categories, and with immediate effect from 2 July 2018 (Monday), the transfer fee for the various Individual membership categories shall be reduced. Please refer to the preceding page 2 for more information.

The upgrading works to the Golf Registration Counter and Admin back-offices were ergonomically and timely completed and reopened on 26 June 2018 (Tuesday). We sincerely thank all our members for your patience, understanding and co-operation in the past 2 months where all Golf Registrations were temporarily shifted to the Octagon. We hope that you will be pleased with the refurbished "open concept" Golf Registration Counter that is now glass-enclosed with air-conditioning and cosy Lounge areas.

To ensure our golf courses are maintained in tip-top condition for golfers' enjoyment, the Club has embarked on a variety of intensive course maintenance and cultural practices to consistently improve the playability and aesthetics of the golf courses. Intensive hollow tining, sand topdressing, fertilisation, verti-cutting and rolling were carried out recently at our 27-hole Greens to reduce soil compaction, improve aeration and absorption of nutrients, encouraging healthier turf growth with a denser and more resilient Greens for play consistency. Following the course maintenance works, some of you may have experienced sandy and bumpy putting surfaces at the Greens. We are heartened to know that most of you understood the importance and necessity of these cultural practices, and that such play conditions are temporary as the Greens would make progressive recovery in two to three weeks' time. Thereafter, golfers can enjoy better consistency of play and trueness across the golf courses. You will also be delighted to know that the upgrading work of the sand bunkers at the Vanda Course is now completed with an efficient drainage system, eliminating water ponding and sand erosion; with a fluffier sand condition for your bunker shot execution. Our Greens Committee would like to thank all golfers for your understanding and support as the Club continues with its cultural practices to improve the golf courses for your golfing enjoyment.

Another upgrading initiative that I am excited to update you about is the revamping of the Club website, which is long overdue. The refreshed website equipped with user-

friendly and more interactive features will be soft-launched on 2 July 2018 (Monday). More features, including the Live Chat function, will be fully rolled out by 1 August 2018 (Wednesday). The Live Chat function allows website visitors and prospects to make enquiries in real time and learn more about our social and corporate events, such as weddings, birthdays, corporate luncheons/dinners, and so forth from our Sales & Marketing Team. 

Through our continuous efforts to provide you with the best golfing experience, the Club carried out bunker upgrading at the Vanda Course and it was completed in end May 2018. This helped to provide a better drainage system, eliminate water ponding and sand erosion, and improve playability. The Club will continue to work very closely with the contractor to ensure the upgraded Vanda bunkers are well maintained.



Hollow Tining At The 27-Hole Greens

Hollow Tining is a cultural practice that must be carried out on the greens 2 to 3 times a year. It is necessary in order to reduce soil compaction, remove the organic layer and encourage healthier turf growth. In June 2018, intensive hollow tining works and sand topdressing was carried out at the Club's 27-hole greens. Coring was done consecutively for four days to achieve consistency in green speed across the three golf courses when the cores are completely recovered.

Once the Greens have been cored, the surfaces will be removed of core residues. Sand topdressing will then be applied. Following the hollow tining and sand topdressing, golfers may experience bumpy and sandy Green surfaces in the first two weeks.



Golfers can look forward to a better consistency in green speed and trueness of putt across the three courses when the cores are completely healed, with denser and more resilient greens turf by the third week to provide an enjoyable golfing experience for all golfers.

We seek your kind patience and understanding as our course maintenance team peruse with the Greens' cultural practices.



Basic Golf Etiquette & Safety

Safety on the golf course is of paramount importance above all else. Golfers who face dangerous play complaints are required to appear before the Club's Disciplinary Committee. If golfers are found to have indeed engaged in dangerous play, they may be suspended from using the Club's facilities for 3 to 9 months, depending on the severity of the offence. There has been a total of about 10 suspensions between the year 2000 to 2018 resulting from dangerous play verdicts passed on to the respondents.

The OCC Golf Bye-law, Golf General Rules 2.3 defined Dangerous Play as per the following:

- Taking a stroke when the players in front are clearly NOT out of range
- Taking a stroke without due care and attention to other persons on the course
- Failure to shout 'fore' or giving warning to other players upon hitting a wayward shot that is likely to cause injury to the person on the course



You SHOULD NOT hit the shot when players in front are still on the fairway/rough within sight/range.



You **SHOULD NOT** hit the shot when the golfers in front are within sight/range and are walking off the green towards the buggy.



You **SHOULD NOT** hit the shot when the golfers in front are within sight/range and are still inside the buggy parked at the buggy parking zone next to the green, getting ready to move on

If you hit an unintentional dangerous shot towards another group of golfers, move forward to apologise sincerely to them. If a golfer is hurt by your shot, please attend to him immediately and get your fellow flight mate to seek help by calling the Emergency Number (displayed on the buggy wind screen. If the injury is serious, the evacuation should be conducted by professional medical staff in an ambulance. Do call 995 for an ambulance or get the Golfing staff to call the ambulance for assistance.

Good golfing etiquette starts with members stepping up to be a good role model and showing their guests the right thing to do on the golf course. We are all in this together to take charge of each other's safety and well-being on the golf course. Happy Golfing!


Better Posture For More Consistent Strikes

Regardless of a player's skill level, having solid contact with the golf ball is one of the most satisfying feelings in golf. Here are some key pointers on incorrect postures to avoid and correct postures to adopt, so that it can help you to store power and strike the ball in a more consistent way.



Common Incorrect Postures at Set-up =







This is another common incorrect posture. The upper back is excessively curved with the chin tucked in, forming a "C"shaped posture. This posture locks down your upper body, stopping it from turning effectively during your swing.



Correct Posture



To get into the correct posture, stand upright and adjust your hips such that your belt line is parallel to the ground. You might feel like you have to 'roll' the front of your hips inwards.




From the previous stance, you can bend forward from your hips to achieve the correct posture.

2. Walk your left arm and right leg forward, and then your right arm and left leg. Keep moving forward in this position, keeping your weight evenly distributed between your arms and legs.

Reverse Lunges to Face-Pull - [12 reps, 3 sets]



1. Begin the movement with your arms fully extended to the front and your hands in a pronated (palms down) grip. Take a large step back and do a reverse lunge. Keep your core tight and back upright.



2. As you return to standing position, pull your hands back toward your face, and retract your shoulder blades. Be sure to keep your elbows elevated and in-line with your shoulders throughout the movement.


